ANNA'S STORY



In 2025, Anna took part in the Cancer Council Tasmania Women's 5km Walk/Run for the first time, just months after losing both her beloved mum, Jenny Grimes, and her gran to cancer. Struggling with grief, Anna found comfort in walking and was inspired to join the event alongside her Aunty Sal.

Wanting to honour her loved ones while supporting Tasmanians impacted by cancer, Anna registered straight away and set a fundraising goal of \$500 with her young family. In the lead-up to the event, she undertook a deeply personal challenge called "Walking Forwards with Grief", retracing her mum's favourite walks on what became known as the Jenny Grimes Circuit. Sharing the journey online brought an outpouring of kindness and support.

On event day, Anna and her daughter Lily joined thousands of participants dressed in pink, united by their experiences with cancer. Surrounded by hugs, smiles and shared strength, Anna felt less alone. Together they crossed the finish line raising an incredible \$1,413.

Now, Anna is proud to continue her involvement with the Women's 5km as a member of the 2026 Committee. Passionate about supporting Tasmanian families facing cancer, she hopes to inspire others to walk, run, fundraise or volunteer.

As you make your way around the event, see if you can find every mascot. Once you've spotted them all, scan the QR code below and enter your answers online for your chance to win a prize.

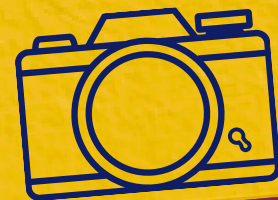

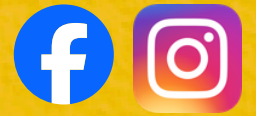

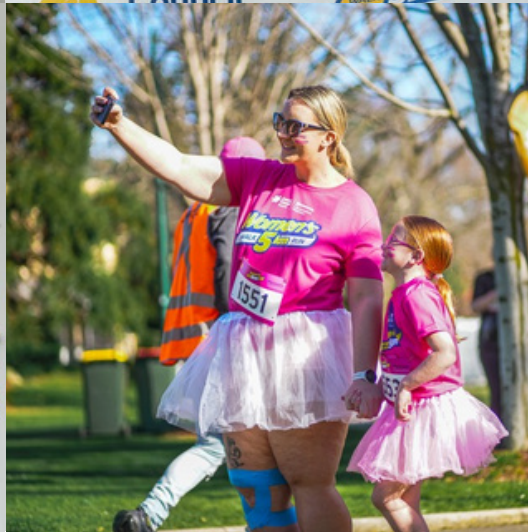
